Table for Four Luncheon



Enrollment/What to Bring

- 1. Completed membership application
- 2. Child's shot/immunization records
- 3. Birth certificate (9 years and under ONLY)
- 4. Proof of Income (one of the following documents): Current tax return, end-of-year paycheck stub, written notice from a social service agency (not more than 30 days old)
- 5. Special Care Plan (asthma, IEP, etc.)


